By this motion, Mr. Smith seeks leave of Court to travel *within the State of Texas* for business purposes, without having to request specific and advance permission from the Court or the Community Supervision Department before traveling.

IV.

Should his employer ask him to travel *outside of Texas*, Mr. Smith will seek permission from his supervising officer, or from this Court before traveling, and will not travel outside the State unless that permission is granted on a case-by-case basis.

V.

Undersigned counsel has conferred with Assistant District Attorney Jeffrey Wright who advises that he has no objection to the request contained in this motion.

WHEREFORE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Joe Smith respectfully requests that he be allowed to travel for business purposes outside Bexar County and anywhere within the State of Texas while on community supervision without first seeking permission to do so from the Court or the Bexar County Adult Community Supervision Department.
